HKIAC Boosts Mainland Ties with New Hire

Hong Kong · 18 January 2008 – The Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC), Asia’s leading dispute resolution body, is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. LIU Jing as Deputy Secretary-General with effect from 1 February 2008.

Mr. LIU, a former member of the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission (CIETAC) Secretariat in Beijing, studied law in China and holds an LLM degree from the University of California at Berkeley. He also practiced law as a member of the international arbitration group of a major international law firm before joining the HKIAC. In his new position, Mr. LIU will be in charge of Mainland Affairs.

“Building closer ties between Hong Kong and arbitration bodies and users in mainland China is an important goal of the HKIAC” said Dr. Michael MOSER, Chairman of the HKIAC. “We are extremely fortunate to have a person with Mr. Liu’s experience as part of our team.”

Mr. Christopher TO, Secretary-General of the HKIAC said: “More and more of our cases have a connection to the mainland. Having Mr. LIU on board will enable us to further promote the benefits of arbitration and mediation in Hong Kong.”

The HKIAC will begin a public relations drive in mainland China in the spring of this year, following the promulgation of new Administered Arbitration Rules scheduled to come into effect on 1st March 2008.
